

Girl Scout Scholarship Eligibility



The Turner Chapel AME Church Girl Scout Scholarship Award will be awarded to participating graduating high school seniors demonstrating church and community involvement through Girl Scouts. Scholarships will be awarded annually based on available funding.

• Applicants must be active members of the Turner Chapel Girl Scout program.

Required Documents

- Most Recent High School Transcript
- Leader Recommendation (Any level 8107 Troop Leader)
- Essay What My Girl Scout Experience Has Meant to Me (200 words single space; 12pt.)
- Evaluation Points Accumulated (Applicants must provide documentation and describe when/how criteria was met)

A review will be conducted by the Girl Scout Leadership team to determine the amount of points that your Girl Scout has earned towards eligibility for the Turner Chapel AME Church Girl Scout Scholarship Award.
