Dear Scholarship Applicant:

All applications become the property of The Harold "Bob" Wise, Jr. Black & Old Gold Scholarship Committee and will not be returned. The award recipient will be announced no later than May 27, 2024.

Guidelines

The Harold "Bob" Wise, Jr. Black & Old Gold Scholarship was created to assist students with the high cost of college expenses.

Awards are open to males who are planning to attend an accredited post-secondary institution as a full-time student and meet all of the below criteria:

- Active member of Turner Chapel AME Church.
- Minimum Cumulative GPA of 2.50 on a 4.0 scale.
- Official proof of acceptance from a two year or four-year accredited post-secondary institution.
- Proof of participation in a community service activity or project.

- Submit two letters of references from a high school teacher/counselor, administrator, or community or church leader. At least one of the two letters of reference should come from the community service organization. Letters from relatives are not acceptable.
- Participate in an interview, if requested.

Application Process

Applicants must send:

- A completed application including the essay. The essay should be no more than two pages in length (**300-word count minimum**), typed, and based on the topic: “What is the most significant challenge facing your generation, and what solutions would you propose to address it?”
- An official copy of high school transcript in a sealed envelope.

Incomplete applications and applications postmarked after May 3, 2024 will not be considered.

Selection Process and Notification

Scholarship recipients are selected according to merit on a competitive basis. In addition, applicants must demonstrate career and academic potential measured by a combination of factors, including past performance and career objectives. Not all applicants will receive awards. Applicants will be notified regarding the status of the award.

Award and Payment

The Harold “Bob” Wise, Jr. Black & Old Gold Scholarship is a one-time award in the amount of \$500.00. Awards are non-renewable. Awards are paid in one installment and made payable directly to the recipient. The decision of the Committee is final.

Revision Policy

The general conditions and procedures under which scholarships are made are subject to periodic review by the Harold “Bob” Wise, Jr. Black & Old Gold Scholarship Committee, including termination of the program.

Missing any of the above items will result in an incomplete package and will not be considered for an award. Application must be postmarked by May 3, 2024.
